

Visa Process

The Australian Student Visa (Subclass 500) allows international students to study in Australia for up to five years. To qualify:

- **1. Enrollment:** Enroll in a registered course and provide a Confirmation of Enrollment (COE).
- 2. Health Cover: Obtain Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).
- 3. English Proficiency: Demonstrate English proficiency.
- 4. Financial Capacity: Show proof of funds for tuition and living expenses.
- **5. Health and Character:** Pass health examinations and provide a police clearance certificate.



Post Study Opportunities

After completing your studies, you can extend your stay and explore career prospects through the Temporary Graduate Visa (Subclass 485). This visa has two streams:

- **1. Graduate Work Stream:** For qualifications matching jobs on the Skills Occupation List (SOL), typically granted for 18 to 24 months.
- 2. Post-Study Work Stream: For those with bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degrees from recognized Australian universities. Duration varies based on the degree obtained.

- Completion of a CRICOS-listed course for at least 16 months.
- Ensure institution and course meet required standards.
